



What's That You Say? Smart Speakers and Voice Assistants Toplines

Methodology: This **SurveyMonkey Audience** survey was conducted February 8-11, 2019, among 1,127 parents of children age 2-8 in the United States. Respondents for these surveys were selected from more than 2 million people who take surveys on the SurveyMonkey platform each day. The modeled error estimate for the full sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points. Data have been weighted for age and sex using the Census Bureau's American Community Survey to reflect the demographic composition of the United States age 18 and over.
